Common name: Sweet Osmanthus, Sweet Olive, Tea Olive, Fragrant Olive.

Height: 3-8M

Soil: well drained soil. Full sun to half shade.

Flowering: Clusters of creamy white to pale yellow flowers, followed by purple-black fruits.

Osmanthus fragrans, also known as Sweet olive, is an evergreen shrub or small tree. Osmanthus fragrans has green-burgundy, leathery oval leaves with toothed edges. The clustered flowers of the Sweet Olive are creamy white to pale yellow and are very fragrant.
