Eriobotrya japonica, also known as Japanese Plum or Loquat is a small evergreen fruit tree, also grown as a large shrub. Popular for its large characteristic dark green leaves, with a light green and slightly fuzzy bottom surface. Next to its beautiful downy foliage and fragrant flowers, it bears delicious gold yellowish edible fruits.
